Superintendent Search News Release

The South Delta School District Board contracted with the Mississippi School Boards Association (MSBA) to assist in the search for the superintendent of the South Delta School District. The Board members believe that advertising the search and recruiting interested applicants will benefit the school district and its students.

The superintendent search announcement and application have been posted at the MSBA website (www.msbaonline.org) and at the district's website (southdelta.k12.ms.us). The board has set the deadline for applications as February 20, 2020.

Dr. Mike Waldrop, Executive Director of MSBA, will send an email to contacts on the MSBA mailing list announcing the search and requesting assistance in publicizing the vacancy.

Applications will be reviewed, analyzed, and evaluated by MSBA according to the requirements set forth in *MS Code of 1972, 37-9-13*, which outlines the criteria which must be met to qualify as a superintendent in Mississippi or the criteria outlined in Mississippi Department of Education Alternative Qualifications for Prospective District Superintendents of Education. MSBA will provide this information to the board members.

At the conclusion of the application process, the board members will review all applications and will decide which applicants they wish to interview. Following the interview process, the board will appoint the new superintendent.

The Board is proceeding through each step of the search process with care and diligence due to the importance of the decision as to who will be the leader of the South Delta School District.
